Dear Parents and Carers,

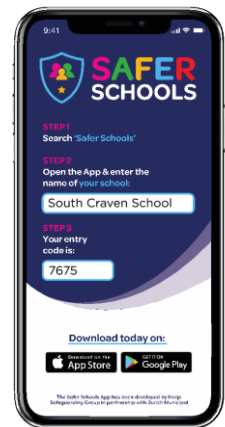
Today is Safer Internet Day 2022, which aims to promote a safer and better internet for all. It's important for you to understand what your child is doing online, so you can help make them safer. We are delighted to invite you to download our new **Safer Schools App**, available to parents, carers, students and staff. Safer Schools is designed to support and protect children by educating and empowering them both at school and home. You will receive tips and advice on how to keep your child safer online, and also support with lots of other safeguarding advice - your child will get access to information relevant to them.

Please note - this is not a platform where we share school information with you such as South Craven events, this is a fantastic resource that is created and kept relevant at all times by experts such as the police. It is there to support you with the challenging and complex world of online issues, how best to support your child and where to get support if needed.

We encourage you to sit down with your child and download the app for them and you. The app is free and available on phones, tablets and computers. The app can be downloaded in three easy steps:

1. Search 'Safer Schools' in your App Store and download the app
2. Open the app and enter 'South Craven'
3. Type in the entry code (details below)

The entry code is dependent on who is using the app. The code for parents and carers is **7675**. Student codes have been emailed to parents, carers and students.
